1. Call to Order and Introductions

Ms. Lanz called the Senior Services Advisory Council (SSAC) meeting to order at 1:32 p.m. Everyone present introduced themselves.

Ms. Farrell noted that since they only had two members present that they did not have a quorum and would have to approve minutes at the next meeting.

2. COVID-19 Updates

Ms. Emery said that S&DS had entered phase one of reopening their building on July 6, 2020. They were still encouraging teleworking but had a few people in the office who were social distancing. Their limited lobby hours were 10am – 12pm every day.

Ms. Emery mentioned that they were doing their assessments over the phone. The only service that was meeting with people in person was Adult Protective Services (APS), but that was only in emergency situations.

Ms. Emery stated that these would be the only changes until COVID-19 numbers went down again.

3. Cottage Grove Facility Search Update

Ms. Farrell said that they had decided to move into the Cottage Grove Community Center. The building was looking to expand, so they would have enough space. They would be using an office while the expansion was being built. The community library and senior center were also inside the same building. She said that they were still working on completing the lease agreement.

4. Call for Next Meeting Agenda Items

Next Meeting: September 18, 2020

Ms. Farrell stated that they would talk about everything they went over that day at their next meeting, so all Council members were on the same page.

Ms. Susman said that they had had issues with people calling Cascade Manor thinking they could help with in-home care. They had been put down in the Aging and Disability Resource Connection (ADRC) as a place that did in-home care. She also noted that there were three organizations that were not listed that should be. She hoped that S&DS could help her get the information corrected. Ms. Lanz said that she would get in touch with her to make the changes.

Ms. Huebner-Sannes asked if they were ever given the contact sheet for the Council. Ms. Lanz said that she had sent it out but would do it again. She reminded everyone that the list only included information from Council members that said they wanted it shared.

5. Adjournment

Ms. Lanz adjourned the meeting at 1:53 p.m.
